ENTRY TO THE SPECIALIST REGISTER AS AN "ELIGIBLE SPECIALIST"

On 1 January 1997 it became a statutory requirement that a doctor's name appear on the General Medical Council (GMC) Specialist Register in order for the doctor to be eligible for appointment to a substantive or honorary NHS consultant post. A place on the Specialist Register is only required if you intend to take up a substantive or honorary NHS consultant post in the UK. It is not necessary to be on the Specialist Register to work as a locum consultant in the UK or to retain your GMC Registration.
