Dear Sir,

I acknowledge receipt of your letter of 22 March 2000.

I now enclose a form on which you should set out your client's application to the Court. You should complete and return this, together with a photocopy of all relevant documents which you wish to submit, as soon as possible (normally within six weeks). I should draw your attention to the fact that these documents will not be returned to you. Consequently, it is in your interests only to send photocopies, not original documents.

An explanatory note to assist you in completing the form is annexed to it. As you will see from the explanatory note, the Court will examine the case on the basis of the completed form. You should therefore take care to complete it fully and accurately, but you may refer to submissions already made in previous correspondence or pleadings. Failure to return promptly the application form duly completed and signed might affect the date of introduction of your application and thus the six months' time-limit under Article 35 § 1 of the Convention.
